Carme Carrion holds a PhD in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology (2002) from the University of Barcelona, a Master in Biotechnology (1995) from the same University and a Master in Conflictology (2008) from the Open University of Catalonia (UOC). She is currently Health Professor at UOC and part-time Assistant Professor in the University of Girona (UdG).

Previously she has been Senior Researcher at the Agency for Health Quality and Assessment of Catalonia (CAHTA) (2012 – 2016) and the director of Fundació UdG Medicina (a non-profit Organization linked to University of Girona) (2012 – 2015). Her research has gone from the basic biochemical sciences to translational medicine and impact assessment. She is member of the research group Translational Medicine and Decisions Sciences Lab (TransLab) of the UdG and also of the Research Social Impact Group (ISOR) of CAHTA. She is also involved in different education innovative projects.

She has published several papers on scientific journals and had been professor of various graduate and postgraduate modules, mainly in the areas linked to Evidence-Based Medicine, Public Health and Research Methodology. She is also reviewer for different European Projects (FP7 and Horizon 2020 programs) and has been actively involved as Researcher in different European projects in the areas of ICT-Health.
