Ebba Ossiannilsson was awarded the EDEN Fellow title in 2014, and she became Open Education Europa Fellow in 2015. Since 2000, she had worked at Lund University, Sweden, as an e-learning, open online learning expert with a special focus on quality. Ossiannilsson is a freelancing researcher, advisor, and consultant. She is frequently invited to be the keynote speaker at international conferences. She is a board member of national and international associations in the area of open online learning and education. As for example she is currently in the EDEN EC and served for 2 periods (2004-2008) in the EUCEN Steering Committee. She is the Vice President of the Swedish Association for Distance Education. She is also international quality reviewer for EADTU and ICDE. She was the research leader for the ICDE research study on a global overview of quality models, and the evaluator of the SEQUENT project on quality. Ossiannilsson collaborates with the EC ET working group on digital and online learning and with the Commonwealth of Learning. Ossiannilsson is on the editorial boards of several scientific journals. She is a guest editor of the Education Sciences Journal's special issue on MOOCs. She has a passion for contributing to open education in a Future We Want for All, initiated by UNESCO. She earned her PhD at Oulu University in Finland in 2012 with her dissertation, Benchmarking e-learning in higher education: Lessons learned from international projects. In addition to her dissertation, Ossiannilsson has over 200 publications, which include conference papers, journal articles, book chapters, reports, and editing.
