Marta Aymerich holds a PhD in Medicine and Surgery (2002; MD degree in 1993) from the Autonomous University of Barcelona, and a Master in Public Health (MPH) from the Harvard University (1999). She is currently the Vice President for Strategic Planning and Research at the Open University of Catalonia (UOC).

Previously she has been the Head of Health Research and Innovation at the Ministry of Health of the Government of Catalonia (2011-2013) and earlier the Director of the Catalan Agency for Health Technology Assessment and Research (2006-2008), where she developed her professional career as a researcher since 1995. She is member of the research group *Translational Medicine and Decision Science Lab (TransLab)* of the University of Girona (UdG), where she was assistant professor at the School of Medicine from 2008 to 2014. From 2004 to 2006 she was appointed Director of the Interministerial Council for Research and Technological Innovation by the Government of Catalonia.

She has published several papers on scientific journals and had been professor of various postgraduate courses, nationally and internationally, on the areas of health services research, evidence based medicine and research policy. She is reviewer for scientific journals, as well as evaluator for some scientific organizations, for the Spanish Health Research Funds and for the European Framework Program of R&D.
