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Mercè Gisbert has a permanent position as professor at Rovira i Virgili University in the Department of Pedagogy. She is Dr in Educational Sciences and since 1988 has been conducting academic and research activities. She has also held management responsibilities: she was vice-rector of the University Rovira i Virgili (2002-2010). During this period one of her responsibilities was the coordination of continuing education.

Professor Gisbert has participated as a researcher in more than 20 projects during the last 20 years at national and international level. She has also participated in several panels, boards and advisory committees on Technology and Education. She is the coordinator of the interdisciplinary research group ARGET [Applied Research Group in Technology and Education]. She has more than 50 published papers in international journals and has a long experience in the field of Technology and Education especially in eLearning, the use of ICT for the development of continuing education and Live Long Learning. She has been responsible for a PhD and Master degree on Technology and Education. She has supervised 27 doctoral theses. She did a research stay at UBC in Vancouver (Canada) with a grant from the Ministry of Education for senior researchers (2011). She has been a member of the School Council of Catalonia from 2012 to 2016. Since 2012 she is a member of the National Council for Culture and the Arts of Catalonia.
